1. Call to order: Meeting was called to order by Chair Langley Willauer via Zoom at 6:41 pm. Members present via Zoom were Marie Berry, Robert Hall, Junita Hunt, Harold Mosher and Langley Willauer. (The Board acknowledged that with five members present we had a quorum.)
2. Others present via Zoom were Anthony Collins of Collins Custom Services and Ryan Brown (Collins' neighbor).
3. New Business: Public Hearing regarding Site Plan Review for Collins Custom Services- Anthony Collins. Mr. Collins explained the nature of the business he is proposing, small engine repairs, minor auto repairs, auto audio installation and repair, light welding service, furniture repair, and boat and camper repairs. This work will be conducted at his home, both outside and in a 12' x 24' shelter. Hours of operation will be 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. His closest neighbor, Ryan Brown, expressed approval of Mr. Collins' new business. There was no opposition.
